

We Speak Digital: Web 2.0 Tools and Project Organizers

This course will introduce educators to Web 2.0 technologies and challenge them to effectively use these web-based tools to support teaching and learning. Web 2.0 allows everyone to publish text, images, audio and video - to share ideas, receive feedback, and collaborate on projects with people across the street and around the world. During this course you will create blogs, wikis, rss feeds, photo galleries, podcasts, and web-based project organizers. During the final weekend of the course you will envision opportunities to incorporate these technologies into your curriculum via the tools we've built. Course includes 10 hours online field-related coursework.
